



LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 01 – Dredging works on the River Taff and deposition in Cardiff Bay

Mariners are advised that dredging works in the vicinity of Castle and Taff's Mead water bus stop on the River Taff is due to commence on Monday 10th February.

During the dredging works the support vessel will be in operation towing barges between the dredge site and the deposition area in the Bay. The vessel will display lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.

The deposition area in the Bay is marked by four special marks (Yellow buoys). The barges and towing vessel may be stationary for extended periods whilst depositing spoil.

Mariners are requested to keep well clear of the vessels associated with the dredging and clear of the deposition area.

Mariners should note that navigation upstream of Penarth Road Bridge will be restricted whilst the dredging is in progress.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
