No. 05 of 2022 – Bridge inspections River Taff – 27th and 28th April 2022 0900hrs -1500hrs

On the 27th and 28th of April 2022 bridge inspections will be taking place on the Taff Viaduct railway bridge.

27th April

Span 1 (Easternly most span) to be entered / inspected from 09:00hrs until 12:00hrs

Span 2 to be entered / inspected from 12:00hrs until 15:00hrs

28th April

Span 3 to be entered / inspected from 09:00hrs until 12:00hrs

Span 4 (Westerly most span) to be entered / inspected from 12:00hrs until 15:00hrs

The inspections will take place from a modular pontoon structure moved between all four spans.

Mariners are requested to navigate at a slow speed when entering and navigating through the spans when inspections are being undertaken.
