

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No. 06 of 2022 – GB Stand Up Paddle Board Race - River Ely and River Taff– 1st May 2022

The GB Stand Up Paddleboard (SUP) race will take place on the River Ely and River Taff, starting from Cardiff Bay Yacht Club (CBYC), on Sunday 1st May 2022.

The first of six waves will start at 1030 hrs with the last competitor expected to have completed the course by 1500hrs. There will be six accompanying event support vessels on the water at all times.

Turn marks will be positioned adjacent to CBWAC and by the Principality Stadium on the Taff.

Vessels navigating the Rivers are asked to keep wash to a minimum during racing.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
