

## **LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS**

### **No 08 of 2026 – Barrage Outer Harbour and Approach Dredging Activity - Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> April and Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2026**

Mariners are advised that on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> April the dredging vessel *UKD Sea Dragon* will be conducting dredging work in the Cardiff Barrage approach channel and Outer Harbour. The dredging will take place from High Water for approximately 4 hours on the morning and evening tide on both days.

Lock operations may be restricted at times during the period of these works. For the latest information on lock availability, mariners should contact Barrage Control on VHF Channel 18 or by telephone on 02920 700234 in advance of any planned arrival or departure.

Mariners are also advised that if the navigation aid at the end of the Northern Arm (51°26.705'N, 03°39.832'W) is exhibiting three red lights displayed vertically, inbound navigation into the approach channel and outer harbour is strictly prohibited.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
