

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 09 of 2022 – Bristol Channel Yachting Association Annual Conference Pay and Display Pontoons – Friday 1st – 3rd July 2022

The Cardiff Harbour Authority Pay and Display pontoons at Roald Dahl Plass will be reserved for vessels entered into the BCYA Welsh Coast Rally from 1500 on Friday 1st July to 1800 on Sunday 3rd July 2022.

There may still be some very limited public mooring available during this period. Mariners are to be advised that the normal 24 hr maximum stay will be in force for any vessels not part of the Rally.

Alternative moorings will be available as normal in Graving Dock No.3 with a 24hr maximum stay.

A Cardiff Harbour Authority Patrol Vessels will be checking mooring permits, pay and display tickets and App receipts for the duration of the event.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
