LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS – CARDIFF BAY

No: 10, 11 and 12 of 2019

No: 10 – Temporary Exclusion Zone – Aquapark Cardiff

Mariners are advised that from Monday 3rd June until 14th September 2019, a small exclusion zone will be in place adjacent to Cardiff Barrage for Aquapark Cardiff. The area will be marked by a yellow boom (See attached plan A).

Mariners are requested to keep clear of the exclusion zone and to navigate at slow speed in its vicinity to keep wash to a minimum.

No: 11 – British National Water Ski Race – Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th June 2019

On Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th June 2019, rounds of the British National Water Ski Race will be taking place in Cardiff Bay.

Vessels are requested to keep clear of the race area (see attached plan B) between the following times:

Saturday 15th June 1100–1600 hrs

Sunday 16th June 1100-1600 hrs

The race area will be marshalled by Harbour Authority and Race Control vessels. Access to and from the Harbour Authority Pay and Display pontoons at Roald Dahl Plass and the Graving dock will be restricted between 1100 – 1600 hrs on both days.

Public vessels on the pontoons during these times must remain there until the access has re-opened.

Mariners are requested to keep clear of the exclusion zone and to navigate at slow speed in its vicinity to keep wash to a minimum.

No. 12 of 2019 – Cardiff Triathlon – Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd June 2019

On Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd June, the Cardiff Triathlon will be taking place in Cardiff Bay.

Vessels are required to keep clear of the race area (*see attached plan C*) between the following times:

Saturday 22nd June 1330 - 1630 hrs

Sunday 23rd June 0600 - 1230 hrs

The race area will be marshalled by Harbour Authority and Race Control vessels.

The Harbour Authority Pay and Display public pontoons at Roald Dahl Plass will be closed to all vessels during this time.

Alternative moorings will be available as normal in Graving Dock No. 3.

**Mariners are requested to keep clear of the exclusion zone
and to navigate at dead slow speed in its vicinity to keep wash to a minimum.**

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
