LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 10 of 2026 – Bristol Channel Yachting Association Annual Conference Pay and Display Pontoons – Friday 3rd – Sunday 5th July 2026.

The Cardiff Harbour Authority Pay and Display pontoons at Roald Dahl Plass will be reserved for vessels entered into the BCYA Welsh Coast Rally from 0900 on Friday 3rd July to 1800 on Sunday 5th July 2026.

There may still be some very limited public mooring available during this period. Mariners are to be advised that the normal 24 hr maximum stay will be in force for any vessels which are not part of the Rally.

Alternative moorings will be available as normal in Graving Dock No.3 with a 24hr maximum stay.

Cardiff Harbour Authority Patrol Vessels will be checking mooring permits, and App receipts for the duration of the event.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
