

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 13 of 2022 – River Taff Embankment Works Wednesday 29th June to 31st August 2022

Mariners are advised that from Wednesday 29th June 2022 a modular pontoon structure will be moored alongside the sheet piled embankment just down stream of the River Taff railway viaduct. This will be on the river for approximately eight weeks and moved further down stream every 9 days.

The structure will be lit with orange flashing lights on the upstream and downstream outermost overhangs.

Vessels will be able to navigate as normal but Mariners should take extra care when navigating through the viaduct arches as vessels travelling upstream will be further into the channel than normal.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
