# No 13 of 2023 – Temporary Pont-Y-Werin Bridge Closure– Essential Maintenance Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July

Mariners are advised that due to essential maintenance the P-Y-W will be in the grounded position between approx. 0800 and 1600 on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July and not be able to lift. During this time, vessels not requiring a bridge lift will be able to navigate underneath the span. The bridge will remain open for pedestrian traffic.
