

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 14 of 2022 – Cardiff Bay Yacht Club Regatta Two Rivers Race Sunday 10th July 2022

Mariners are advised that 1410 on Sunday 10th July 2022 CBYC will be running a two rivers dinghy sailing race. The course will require sailing dinghies to navigate up the River Taff to a laid turning mark just down stream of the Cardiff Bay Water Activity Centre, before navigating back down stream, across the Bay and up the River Ely to a turning mark close to Cardiff International White Water. Vessels will then turn here before heading back down the river and finishing in front of the CBYC clubhouse.

There will CBYC safety boats on duty during the duration of the race.

A CHA patrol vessel will be on duty in the Bay for the duration of the race.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
