

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 15 of 2023 – Temporary Pont-Y-Werin Bridge Closure– Essential Maintenance Wednesday 19th July 2023

Mariners are advised that due to essential maintenance the P-Y-W will be in the grounded position between approx. 0800 and 1600 on Wednesday 19th July and not be able to lift. During this time, vessels not requiring a bridge lift will be able to navigate underneath the span. The bridge will remain open for pedestrian traffic.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and aim to bring the bridge back into service as soon as possible.
