

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 17 of 2026 – Pier Head Royal Gun Salute - Inner Harbour P&D 60 minute pontoon closure Thursday October 15th 2026

A Royal Gun Salute will be fired on Thursday October 16th at Cardiff Bay to commemorate the occasion of the opening of the Senedd..

There will be no access onto or from the Pay and Display pontoons between 11.30 – 12.30 hrs. Firing will commence at approx. 1210hrs and the Salute will last for 3 min & 20 Secs.

Vessels will be unable to be left moored on the inside berths to a distance of 55m from the firing zone.

A Harbour Authority Patrol Vessel will be ensuring vessels stay clear of the fall out zone.

Alternative mooring will be available in the graving dock.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
