LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 24 of 2022 – Inner Harbour Pay and Display Partial Pontoon Closure Saturday 22nd October

Mariners are advised that the inside finger of the Inner Harbour Pay and Display pontoons will be closed for water rescue demonstration by South Wales Fire and Rescue. This closure will be in force between 0900 hrs and 1600 hrs (see attached plan). Vessels will be able to moor on the outside fingers and end hammerhead only. A Harbour Authority Patrol Vessel and Fire Brigade Safety Vessel will be on the water during the event.

The graving dock will remain open and available for mooring.

No 25 of 2022 – Inner Harbour Pay and Display Closure Sunday 23rd October 1800-0800

Mariners are advised that the Inner Harbour Pay and Display pontoons will be closed from 1800 Sunday 23rd October until 0800 on Monday 24th.

The graving dock will remain available for overnight mooring.

All Vessels wishing to enter or leave Cardiff Bay should contact Barrage Control on VHF Channel 18 and await instructions before entering the Outer Harbour.

Mariners are reminded that CCTV is in operation at the Barrage for operational and health and safety reasons. All CCTV images and VHF transmissions are recorded.
